Home Page

- Quick view into the most recent videos and happenings. Sometimes this is as far as you need to go.

Live

- If you have the opportunity you can watch a live episode or see what is going on live in the chateau. It does cost 7 euros to do though.
- A subheading is *live gratuit*. Use this instead.
- Above the media player it will show you when the next live showing is and what it is about.

Star Ac' TV

- Allows you to access a variety of videos separated by date and time.
- Lets you go beyond the show and into their everyday lives in the castle.
- Below there is also a little TV guide-type schedule showing you what you can watch.

Vidéos

- These are divided into 5 different categories.
 - Vidéos du jour
 - Evaluations
 - Le prime
 - Best of
 - Les Debriefs de Raphie
- Each video is sorted by date and time.

News

- Great source of modern literature, but not the best grammar.
- Does have a video for each reading so the students can see what happens.

Photos

- Good source if you have them do projects.
- There are 3 different categories.
 - Prime
 - Vie de chateau
 - Tous le diaporamas

Candidats

- Bios on all the candidates.
- More specific information as the competition continues.
- There is a wrap up and break down with the videos.
- Latest videos of each candidate.

Les Pros

- Break down of the judges, teachers, and anyone else the students need to know.
- Good for research assignments.

Prime

- This is what is actually shown on TV for the episodes.

Jeux

- Mostly music quizzes.
- Costs money.

Star Ac' World

- A Sims version of the castle.
- Lets the students explore and live in the castle.
- Each candidate created an apartment for you to view.
- Great for vocabulary or a lab assignment.
- Within the Sims world: it does cost money to make the apartments.
 - Le chateau = you can visit the exact chateau used on the show.
 - Les apparts des candidats = visit each candidates' apartment that they have created.
 - Les apparts = view your apartment as well as others.
 - Le prime = visit where the competitions take place.
 - La boutique = buy upgrades for your apartment.

Communauté

- Chat and forum portion.
- See a lot of slang and text lingo.
- View blogs.

WEEK'S LESSON PLAN

Monday – Show the *prime* time episode from Friday night. Have the students vote again show the results. The easiest way to do this is using the *prime* heading.

- Ask who they think will be nominated next. Show them some of the other competitors who sang that day.

Tuesday – Go to the end of the *eval* section and choose the candidates who were nominated. Depending on time, you can throw some others in that weren't picked and see if the students can guess who is going to be singing to stay alive.

Wednesday – Use the *candidats* section or the *star ac TV* section to show progress of the rehearsals and practices. The *candidats* section will have a lot of really good interviews and commentaries as well.

Thursday – Show more interviews of the performers so the students get to know how they are feeling with the upcoming competition. This is a great time to use the *Raphie* section and find out what she and some of the judges think of the competitors.

Friday – Show a *best of* clip from the video section. It's hard to keep track of everything so let the French do that for you.
